




How UWASP Impacts McLeod County

The Impact of Extracurricular Activities

UWMC Launched UWASP in 2015

- Any student grades 5-8 attending a McLeod County School is eligible for up to \$125 a school year for an activity scholarship through UWMC.
- UWMC will fund up to **75**% of the activity.
- Since the program was launched \$11,500 in scholarships have been awarded.
- 200 students in McLeod County have received UWASP scholarships.

The Future of UWASP

- Expanding UWASP beyond 5-8 grade.
- Launch United Way Family Activity Scholarship Program (UWFASP) to ensure programs are accessible for all families in McLeod County
 - o Both of these changes are dependent on dollars raised for the program

TEAM INFORMATION

- 1. Designate a Team Captain to sign up your team here: HERE
- 2. Teams need 8-12 players (All participants must be at least 18 years old)
- 3. Waivers must be signed by each player & handed in by the Team Captain at check-in.
- 4. Each team is asked to raise a suggested minimum of \$150 for UWASP.
 - a. Once a team's registration is confirmed, the team captain will be asked to set-up a fundraising page to reach the minimum goal. The fundraising page should be setup within seven days of registering your team to ensure a spot in the competition. Tools will be provided to help your team achieve fundraising success!
- 5. Volunteer umpires will be present on every field to ensure fair play and to keep teams on the schedule.
- 6. Team uniforms are not required but are HIGHLY encouraged.
- 7. Players will receive one free drink ticket each.
- 8. Food & drink will be available for purchase throughout the day.
 - Alcoholic drinks will be available for purchase on site. You must be 21+ with a valid license to consume alcohol.
 - No outside food/drink please.
